## **Monthly Action Items for Pack Growth Coordinators**

### **2003-2004**

#### **January**

- Review pack plans and goals with pack leadership
- Attend the Cascade Pacific Council's Pack Growth Coordinator Conference

#### **February**

- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
- Evaluate the need for Tiger Cubs in your pack

#### **March**

- Assist with the pack Lost Boy Search for those boys who have dropped out of the pack.
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
- Discuss your pack plans for Spring Tiger Cub recruitment

#### **April**

- Attend the District Kickoff "Fun at Every Turn" at Roundtable and pick up the Fall Roundup Kit for your pack
- Complete a pack member/leader inventory at your pack committee meeting
- Conduct a spring pack joining event for new Cub Scouts and families
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
- Secure a date for your special pack Spring Tiger Cub recruitment activity

#### **May**

- Complete a pack member/leader inventory at your pack committee meeting
- Under the direction of your pack leadership, work together to select leadership for vacant positions for Fall Roundup
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
- Conduct your pack's Spring Tiger Cub recruitment events, including kindergarten school presentations

#### **June**

- Schedule the fall pack open house date with your school before close of school
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters

#### **July/August**

- Set pack membership goals through growth planning conference with DE and Cubmaster
- Secure joining night date for your pack
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
- Attend the District Fall Roundup Training

- Work with parents and Pack leadership to promote and conduct a successful Cub Scout Fall Join Night, including the following:
  - Identify appropriate methods of invitation. (Flyers, stickers, posters, School Open House, Costumes, in-school visits, etc)
  - With the help of other parents, identify a list of boys and families that are not involved in scouting and invite them to join.
  - Prepare and provide manpower for an attractive Pack promotion table for school open house.
  - Work with parents at each grade level to promote Scouting to other parents.
  - Develop a Cub Scout recruiter program where boys recruit other boys.

**September**

- Conduct a pack joining night for your pack during the two week blitz period
- Turn in your new membership applications at your district's Fall Roundup Membership Turn-in rally
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters

**October**

- Promote follow-up joining opportunities for your October Pack Meetings – It's not too late to join!
- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
- Turn in your new membership applications at your district's Fall Roundup Membership Turn-in rally

**November**

- Follow-up with unregistered youth from advancement reports and activity rosters
